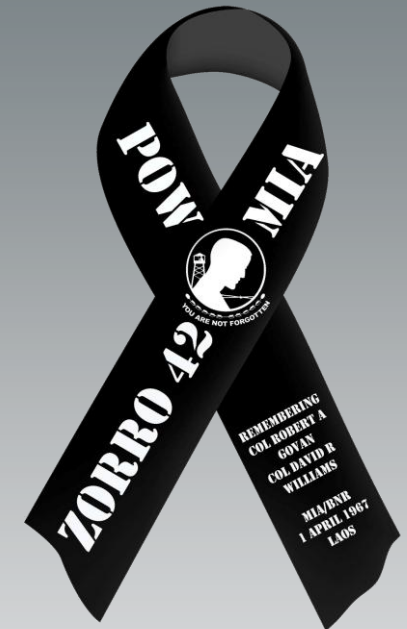

Sponsoring Your Ride

Participants should register early in order to allow time to collect sponsors. The 200 mile ride could be sponsored at 10 cents a mile for a total of \$20. In addition to the registration fee, riders and passengers are asked to raise at least \$100 in pledges. The rider raising the most money will receive a commemorative POW/MIA gift.

The run will benefit American Legion Post 295's Operation Provide Comfort. Since 2003, Post 295's Operation Provide Comfort has provided services to hundreds of wounded warriors, their families and staff of the Bethesda Naval Hospital, now the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center.

The Post's name "Vietnam Veterans Memorial" was chosen to ensure the Vietnam Veterans would not be forgotten. Post 295 works to ensure the staff, wounded warriors and families are not forgotten. Over the past 9 years, Post 295 has supported or provided the following activities:

- Holiday luncheons: In 2011, Post 295's luncheon served more than 140 wounded warriors, their families and hospital staff at the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center (WRNMMC) in Bethesda, MD.
- PTSD/Family Support Group: The support group is a

local outreach program for the families of servicemen, veterans and friends who may be dealing with PTSD in the family. The program provides information on available treatments and tips on the "Do's & Don'ts" when a loved one returns from a deployment. This program is open to those who have an interest in assisting these warriors.

- Quilts of Valor: Provide support to the local chapter of the Quilts of Valor in providing quilts to deserving veterans.
- Fisher House: Provide support to the WRNMMC Fisher Houses ensuring they continue to provide free or low cost housing for families who's loved ones which are receiving care at WRNMMC.
